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Call Claremont Police Department (603) 542-9538 for inspection.

11. Note that the judging of floats takes place at 9 AM while the floats are lined up on Broad Street prior to start of parade.
12. No objects of any kind can be tossed from any float/car as it moves along the parade route. This includes candy and any other item (including water being shot out from water guns.) **NOTHING** is allowed to be tossed from floats/cars in the parade. If your class would like to distribute candy or other items as part of your theme, individuals can walk alongside or behind the float/car to do that.
Any floats violating the rules will be REMOVED FROM THE PARADE. NO EXCUSES. YOUR FLOAT DRIVER WILL BE INSTRUCTED TO TURN OFF THE PARADE ROUTE AND LEAVE THE PARADE.

This is an issue of insurance and safety liability and must be adhered to.

13. A \$100 security deposit must be submitted with your class float application. You can make the check payable to SHS Alumni Association and include it in the envelope you send the application in to Dick Girard's address below. Assume there are no issues with your class float, your refund will be returned to you in full.

See the parade rules of safety, provided by the Claremont Police Department, on the SHS Alumni website under the **SHSAA Documents** tab. Major concerns are the height, length, width of the float as well as the safety of your classmates riding on floats.

Lineup time on Broad Street heading south (from Stevens High School towards the Claremont Middle School) starts at 7:00 AM. Parade kicks off at 10:30 AM.
